“Also, when parents meet other parents with the same concerns, it provides a therapeutic environment where everyone can work to find realistic, practical solutions.”

Whether parents are looking for help in times of crisis, ways to reinforce positive behavior or an opportunity to forge new friendships, the parent support group will provide a healthy forum for discussion and empowerment.
